Statement of Purpose:

The purpose of the Oberlin College Ultimate Alumni Association is to foster communication and community between Oberlin Ultimate Alumni as well as providing support to the current Oberlin Ultimate teams.

Membership:

Membership is open to all Oberlin College graduates and non-graduates who share a passion for Ultimate Frisbee. This covers the alumni of the open and women's club teams (The Flying Horsecows & The Praying Manti) and the pre-1991 coed club team as well as all alumni who discovered Ultimate after graduation.

Leadership:
